Diana J. Alcorn, 64, longtime Ogallala resident, died Thursday, January 29, 2015, in the Ogallala Community Hospital.

Diana was born February 22, 1950 in Monett, Missouri, the daughter of Roy L. and Ludella (Fritz) Conway. In 1956 she moved with her family to Commerce City, Colo.

Diana graduated from Adams City, Colorado, High School in 1968. She was united in marriage to Marvin Alcorn, Sr. in July 1968. The couple made their home in Denver until 1973 when they moved to Fort Collins. They were employed by the A.F. Lavender Ranch .
