



## Donald L. Kramer

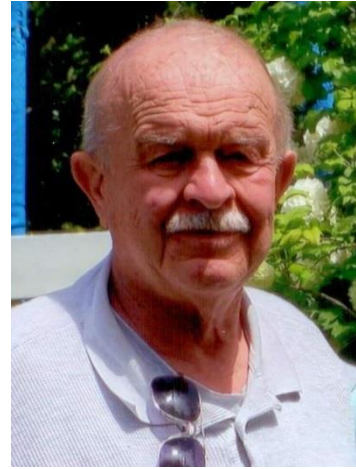
September 10, 1935 – August 7, 2011

Donald L. Kramer, 75, of Taylorsville, Utah, and formerly of Ogallala, died Sunday, August 7, 2011 in his home.
