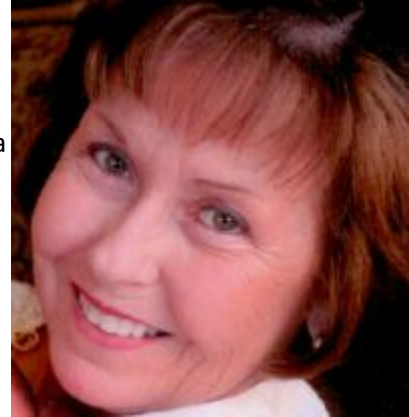


Sally Saunders

Sally Saunders, 63, longtime Ogallala resident, died Tuesday, January 15, 2013 in Great Plains Regional Medical Center in North Platte.
